



Who are we?

We are a charity established to fund critical medical research at University Hospital Southampton NHS Foundation Trust for the benefit of all in the Wessex region and the wider community.

What do we do?

We provide start-up grants for young medical scientists to help them launch their research career.

We also support more advanced research into specific projects such as breast, prostate and ovarian cancers, cervical cancer Alzheimer's disease and osteoporosis.

What are we doing right now?

- We provide five grants of up to £20,000 a year to early career researchers
- We are currently funding eight PhD studentships—helping to foster the next generation of medical researchers
- We are funding an investigation into the effects of Child Brain Injury
- In 2013, we facilitated the purchase for £470,000 of a Mass Spectrometer which has greatly speeded up the analysis of data in connection with cancer research
